Welcome to 2024! Some things will change, and some things will not. Things that will remain include our associational ministries. The needs of Camp Harris, Baptist Collegiate Ministries at Tech in Ruston, and Rolling Hills grow year to year as their ministries expand. Added to those is our support of the Granberry Counseling Center, Bible distribution at our Truck Stops, ministry support to our churches and pastors through our office. Our associational churches have cooperated in these ministries for decades. I want to thank you for allowing me to be a part of these ministries as your Director of Missions.

Things that change, me! By June 1, I will retire. You will call a new Director of Missions, although with a title change, DOM to AMS (Associational Mission Strategist). I ask that as you make that change, you recommit to our existing ministries. I also ask you to make a new commitment to your new Associational Mission Strategist. Pray for him, support him, and by all means welcome him and fellowship with him as you did with us.

Allow me to be candid with you at this point about our need for support. In recent years our giving has not kept up with inflation and our expanded needs. We have been operating for the past 5 years on the same budget. Reasons for that are many. Some churches have shrunk due to aging congregations, some have left the Southern Baptist Convention resulting in churches leaving our associations as well. Some are now supporting other independent ministries and missions other than our cooperative ones, and some just never recovered from Covid. The end result, unless we receive more mission contributions this year, we will actually have to go from a flat budget to a decreased one. Please pray about your church contribution to our associational ministry and if possible, please give more. Our needs have not decreased but increased.

We continue to receive resumes for the new AMS. The committee is working. Pray for them! They will be collecting resumes then prayerfully considering them. They hope to nominate a new director for you by June 1

We traveled to Portugal, Spain, and Gibraltar, England, with our family during Christmas. My burden for Europe intensifies each time we go. Each Christmas while there we make plans for our Easter Portugal Mission trip. This year we have set March 21-30, 2024. In order to make the trip each member will need to go through background checks and training. I will need to know by February 1, if you are interested in making the trip so we can begin the vetting process. Pray for the team members that God will call to make this journey.




