Letter from our Associational Missions Strategist, Jeff Hoffman

Xi Jinping (China's leader) along with Kim Jong-un (North Korean Leader) and Russian President Vladimir Putin, and other leaders including Iran and Pakistan led a crowd through Beijing as they prepared for a military parade seemingly to try to establish a new world order as reported by the mainstream media on September 3, 2025. It is another news story that can cause fear and anxiety. The days in which we live can be unsettling and bring on a sense of despair. This is true not only for our culture but for the church. We see the decline and less emphasis on spiritual things. The world seems to be out of control, and our church response has not been seemingly up to the task.

Reminders of the last days are spoken of in Scripture. Matthew 24:9 records the words of Jesus, "then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted and shall kill you and ye shall be hated of all nations for my names sake..." and also in verse 44, "Therefore be ye ready; for in such an hour as ye think not the Son of man cometh."

So what are we to do and how are we to prepare? It is during these times that the Word of God is imperative. Not only to read it, but to study it, believe it, live it, and to share it. We know that we are near the last days. We know the church will decline and many will fall away (1 Timothy 4:1) and that few will be saved (Matthew 7:13-14). However, there will be a remnant of the church, and those who endure to the end will be saved (Matthew 24:13). We have the sweet presence of the Holy Spirit to be with us during the most difficult times. Our preparation needs to be focused on the things above and not on things of the earth (Colossians 3:2).

As we think about faithfulness to the Kingdom of God and the stewardship of our time, it will behoove us to think about the direction of our lives.... where we spend our time and how we spend our resources. Joshua Becker is the author of the book Things That Matter, and quotes Seneca the Younger a Roman philosopher born about the same time as Jesus of Nazareth. Seneca said, "It is not that we have a short time to live, but that we waste a lot of it. Life is long enough, and a sufficiently generous amount has been given to us for the highest achievements if it were all well invested. But when it is wasted in heedless luxury and spent on no good activity, we are forced at last by death's final constraint to realize that it has passed away before we knew it was passing. So it is: we are not given a short life but we make it short, and we are not ill- supplied but wasteful of it... Life is long if you know how to use it."

It is important for us to remember what Jesus said in Matthew 16:18, "And I say unto thee, That thou are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church, and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it." This is a powerful reminder that the church will survive and continue to have as its mission the glory of God. It is my prayer that we can focus on being faithful to the end and pray the prayer of Jesus, "Not my will, but Thy will be done."


